is a small company that went from "a one-man operation to 14," said owner, Corey Fillip.

Fillip moved to Indianapolis in 1989 for a two-month job as a crew chief for an Indy Car team. Advanced all began from one decision to start helping racers with their shocks, and by 1991 Advanced Racing Suspensions, Inc. had begun. "We do everything from quarter midget (shocks) to stock cars," said Fillip.

Fillip also has personal experience in quarter midgets with his daughter, Jennifer (18). Jennifer Fillip began racing in 2002. She never got into building shocks herself, but when Corey needs help around the shop Jennifer is willing to help. "I just help get ready for big races by putting shocks in boxes and putting parts away," said Jennifer.

Advanced offers a personal touch to racing that many big companies cannot offer, "When you call the shop, I answer," said Fillip. When customers call, Fillip finds what they need and builds shocks specifically for their car.
